

FiftyForward Martin Center Alcoholic Beverages Policy

The use of alcoholic beverages (Champagne, wine, beer *only*) by parties or individuals using the Martin Center under a Facilities License Agreement shall only be permitted within these guidelines:

- 1. The licensee is responsible for all actions of guests. Alcohol should only be used responsibly. The licensee is responsible for designating non-drinking drivers when needed or to call a taxi service if necessary.
- 2. The licensee is responsible for adhering to all state and local regulations governing the consumption and serving of alcoholic beverages.
- 3. The sale of alcoholic beverages is prohibited.
- 4. Alcoholic beverages must be served with the accompaniment of substantial food (a meal or heavy hors d'oeuvres).
- 5. Alcoholic beverages must be served by a designated bartender at least 21 years or older who is in attendance at the bar at all times. The bartender must be named on your event worksheet.
- 6. Champagne fountains and beer kegs are prohibited.
- 7. No alcoholic beverages may be brought onto the premises or taken from the premises by guests.
- 8. Alcoholic beverages may be served or consumed only during licensed hours.
- 9. All beverages must be poured and served in a glass or cup. Drinking from cans or bottles is prohibited.

10. THE BAR MUST BE CLOSED ONE HOUR BEFORE THE END OF THE EVENT.

Martin Center personnel have the authority to close a bar at any time if deemed necessary for the safety of guests and protection of the Center. Local law enforcement will be contacted if there is any problematic behavior during the event.
