Victims benefit from

Care Management:

- Needs assessment
- In-home or safe location interview
- Connection to local services
- Safety planning

Legal Advocacy:

- assistance with obtaining an Order of Protection
- information on court, offender related information (release dates, hearings, probation, parole)
- transportation and/or escort to court proceedings

In-Home services assistance:

- activities of daily living
- light housekeeping
- meal preparation
- grocery shopping
- transportation

Counseling Support

- crisis intervention
- dealing with anxiety
- working through depression

Victory Over Crime refers survivors to community services for:

- therapy
- support groups
- medical needs
- housing
- alcohol/drug treatment

To qualify, you must:

- Be 50 years of age or older
- Be a victim or close family member
- Live in Davidson County (or the crime occurred in Davidson County)
- Not involved in the crime
