### Care Management:

- Needs assessment
- In-home or safe location interview
- Connection to local services
- Safety planning

### Legal Advocacy:

- assistance with obtaining an Order of Protection
- assistance with completing eligible criminal injuries compensation applications
- information on court, offender related information (release dates, hearings, probation, parole)
- transportation and/or escort to court proceedings

### In-Home services assistance:

- assistance with grocery shopping
- transportation
- more intensive in-home services available if eligibility criteria is met

### Counseling Support

- crisis intervention
- dealing with anxiety
- working through depression

*You can receive assistance even if you decide not to pursue legal action.*

### To qualify, you must:

- Be 50 years of age or older
- Be a victim or close family member
- Live in Davidson County (or the crime occurred in Davidson County)
- Not be involved in the crime
