

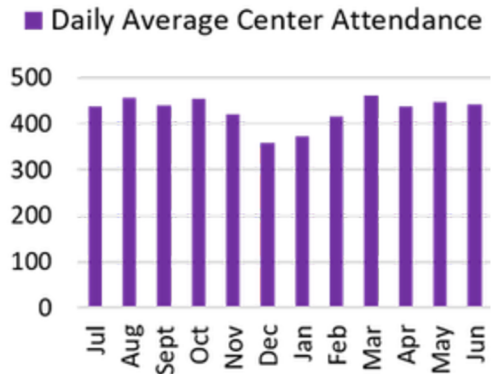


Fiscal Year in Review

- Over **425 older adults** attended FiftyForward centers daily!

- **859 new members** joined the fun across FiftyForward's seven lifelong learning centers!



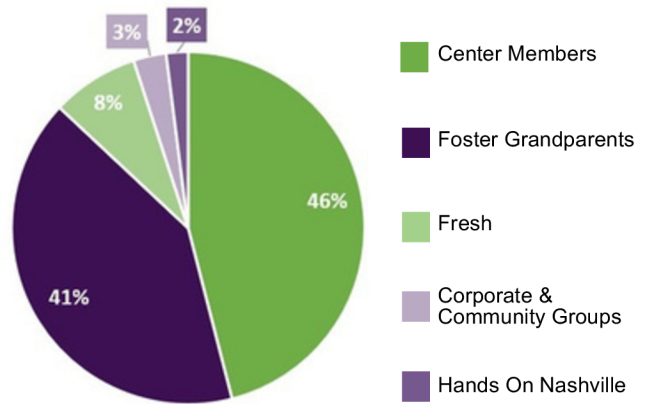
Supportive Care Services

Volunteer Impact

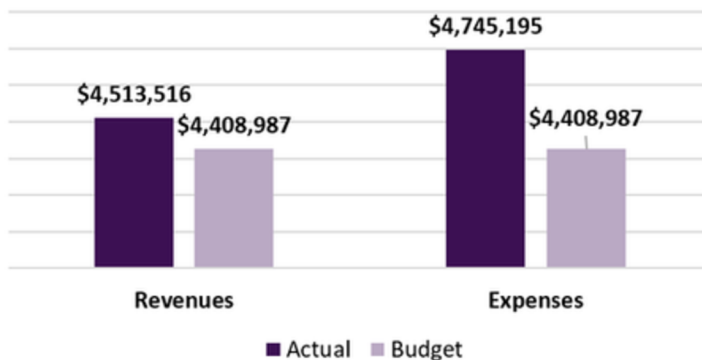
- **More than 1,200 volunteers** gave over 42,000 hours of service to our Middle Tennessee community

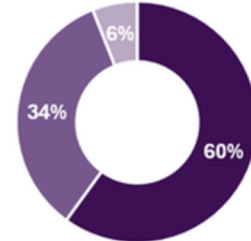
